DNR Report - Jennifer Semrau

- DNR staff conducted a holiday waste media briefing last week which was picked up by a number of media outlets across the state. The briefing was recorded for the media to use in their broadcasts. Three members of the WMM team spoke on different topics.

- New Recycling Specialist LTE who started last month is moving out of WI, will be rehiring that position after the holidays. Please tell anyone who may be interested to keep an eye out for posting.
- Working on draft rule language related to statewide recycling efforts, will discuss draft proposals at WIRMC
- Yesterday (12/14) we received approval from the Natural Resources Board to hold a public hearing on the preliminary scope statement for landfills and solid waste fees rulemaking. The hearing is next week Thursday, December 22, at 1:00 pm over Zoom.

- We are still in the early stages and no rule language has been developed. However, any general comments received, whether in support or against conducting the rulemaking, will be shared with the Natural Resources Board at its January 25, 2023, meeting.
- EPA released more information on federal recycling infrastructure and outreach grant programs. The Solid Waste Infrastructure for Recycling grant includes non-competitive allocation for states and we intend to apply sent notice of intent to participate to EPA (by 12/15 deadline). DNR is also partnering with The Recycling Partnership on their grant application for the Recycling Education and Outreach Grant, which would bring an educational portal to WI allowing small municipalities to order and mail customized recycling education to their residents.
